(Hood River) The Gorge White House is completing its gallery schedule and invites local artists and photographers to submit a notice of interest for solo exhibitions for the 2009 season. The Gorge White House is located at 2265 Highway 35, four miles south of Hood River. In addition to featuring local art and photography, The Gorge White House serves and sells wine and microbrews exclusively from the Columbia River Gorge in a historic home on a century old working farm. It is a unique venue for art, wine, beer, flowers, fresh local fruit and stunning mountain views. In 2008, The Gorge White House hosted the Watercolor Society of Oregon, the Columbia Art Gallery Plein Air artists and visitors from all 50 states and 46 foreign countries.

The Gorge White House features one local artist a month April - October of each year. Gallery space typically allows for 8 – 15 works of art depending on size.
